St. James Cavalier is offering a school visit for both primary and secondary classes. These visits aim at explaining the role of St James Cavalier from its beginning, as a war machine, to its present usage, as a centre for creativity.

Besides the historical aspect, these visits include a detailed yet exciting explanation of the exhibits on show as well as an art workshop.

The art workshop commences with an introduction to some of the most popular artists and their work such as Mondrian, Picasso, Matisse and Kandinsky. The students will then be guided by visual art animators and given various materials to create their own '**work of art**' by working from the exhibitions on show at the centre during the time of the visit.
